

**CHRIST LUTHERAN CHURCH
CALLED CHURCH COUNCIL MEETING
FEBRUARY 7, 2010**

A church council/congregational meeting was held to vote on calling Pastor Roger Sedlmayr of Fargo, North Dakota to be pastor of Christ Lutheran Church. Opening prayer was offered by Pastor Keith Kubitz. Larry Franklin, president of church council, opened the meeting and introduced Jim McDonald, chairman of the call committee.

Jim asked the call committee to come up front to be available for questions concerning the call. Those members being, Don Goodpasture, Pam Kennedy, Becky Meeks, Sue Huenergardt, Billy Guetersloh and Larry Franklin. A Resolution to extend a call to Reverend Roger Sedlmayr was read by Jim McDonald. It read as follows: WHEREAS the task of the Call Committee of Christ Lutheran Church is to serve the Lord and the church by assisting the congregation in finding and calling a pastor. and

WHEREAS a list of pastoral candidates has been received from the Texas District President for the office of Pastor at Christ Lutheran Church, and

WHEREAS the call committee has conducted phone interviews to determine the candidates' experience and philosophy of ministry, and

WHEREAS, phone interviews and a personal visit of Pastor Roger Sedlmayr and his family seem to indicate that he has the unique gifts, skills, characteristics and abilities desired by Christ Lutheran Church; therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Call Committee recommends that nomination of Pastor Sedlmayr to become pastor of Christ Lutheran Church, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the members of Christ Lutheran Church vote to extend a call to Pastor Sedlmayr, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Spiritual Board Director implement the call process with the necessary financial information.

A motion was made and seconded to accept the resolution. Members of the call committee were asked to make comments as to why this Pastor should be called. Some of those comments were: Very personable, outgoing, wanted to meet with officers, staff, express the idea that everyone should be in Bible study, would like to meet with congregational chairman once a week, wants families involved with youth, did not show concerns with location or church, wants leadership in congregational members, his son mingled with Christ Lutheran's youth and there was some mention of having a Director of Community Outreach (DCO).

There was some concern expressed that members don't fall back on participating once we have a Pastor.

The vote was unanimously in favor of the call. The call will now be sent by the call committee.

Tamara Thompson presented Becky Meeks with an appreciation gift for serving as Sunday School Superintendent for the past two years.

Being no further business, the meeting adjourned and members enjoyed a lunch hosted for the benefit of the youth
