

Christ Lutheran Church Congregational Meeting

April 15, 2009

This meeting of Christ congregation was held to present the results of the Congregational Self Study forms that were completed by members as required in the process to call a new pastor.

The meeting, attended by forty-seven members, was called to order by President Tom Jackson at 7:05 PM. He then introduced Rev. Steve Misch, Texas District Mission and Ministry Facillatator.

Pastor Misch offered an opening prayer asking God to help and guide our congregation as we proceed in our call for a new pastor.

He then gave a power point presentation which summarized the ninety-nine completed forms, ranking each item in priority each of the categories. The information is also available on our CLC web site in the password protected area. Texas District President, Rev. Ken Hennings, will use this information to match pastoral candidates with the ministerial needs expressed by members of the congregation.

A summary of the Congregational Health Study form, church history data from the past five years, compiled by members of the Ad Hoc committee was also presented and will be made available on our web site for members to review.

Pastor Tim Radkey, who also attended the meeting, noted that we need a visionary plan and have our priority needs established before we call a pastor for our congregation.

Many items that people had questions about were discussed in detail by Pastor Misch and Pastor Radkey. Both also stressed that we keep this call process in our prayer.

The meeting adjourned at 8:45PM. Pastor Radkey extended a thank you to all in attendance and closed with prayer.
